The City of Wolverhampton Council will process your personal data and special category data on behalf of your school under contract / agreement. We process this data for employment purposes to assist in the running of the school and/or to enable individuals to be paid. The collection of this information will benefit both national and local users by:

- improving the management of workforce data across the sector

- informing the development of recruitment and retention policies
- allowing better financial modelling and planning
- enabling ethnicity and disability monitoring; and
- supporting the work of the School Teachers' Review Body

Personal data collected includes;

- Names and addresses
- National Insurance Numbers
- Financial details – bank account and remuneration details

Special Category data collected includes;

- Ethnicity
- Absence details
